Thank you very much for your participation and cooperation to the 15th International Heat Transfer Conference (IHTC-15) in Kyoto.

According to the Conference Program, it was started with the two special events open to the public on August 9th and followed by the technical sessions and social programs until August 15th. Although the arrival of an unexpected typhoon affected the travel of some participants on the 9th and 10th, the weather was stable at moderate temperatures throughout the conference period. With about 1,200 participants joining from more than 40 countries, two plenary invited lectures, 29 keynote lectures, two panels and 699 rigorously reviewed papers were presented. The four international awards were presented at the banquet on the 14th. I am very much pleased to note that every event and session has been carried out as planned with your professional services and supports.

We aimed that the Conference would be an excellent opportunity for participants to get together, exchange the state-of-the-art knowledge, and develop their human network in a very friendly and comfortable environment. Therefore, we set forth an important question about the role of thermal science in meeting societal challenges as a grand theme of the Conference and encouraged discussion in a broader framework during the Conference. We employed oral presentation for the general papers instead of posters to facilitate essential Q&As. A small USB card was used to contain all papers without bulky printed proceedings. We provided a free Wi-Fi access in every room and the EventMobile app for mobile device users to access to various information, and also tried to get quality Japanese foods, "Washoku." The Program Booklet was another particular effort to make it easy to find parallel session programs and any information needed for one's stay. I hope all of the participants have enjoyed these arrangements.
